Do good to those who hate you, <sup>28</sup> bless those who curse you, and pray for those who mistreat you. <sup>29</sup> When they slap you on one cheek, turn and give them the other; when they take your coat, let them have your shirt as well. <sup>30</sup> Give to all who beg from you. When someone takes what is yours, don't demand it back.

"Do to other what you would have them do to you. <sup>32</sup> If you love those who love you, what credit does that do you? Even 'sinners' love those who love them. <sup>33</sup> If you do good only to those who do good to you, what credit does that do you?
